

Mississippi Beef Agribition Show Calf Sale Rules and Regulations

All show calves should be delivered to the Pontotoc County Agri-Center, Pontotoc, MS. by 4 PM Friday, March 23, 2018.

The deadline for nominating heifers is **Friday, January 20, 2018**. All animals must be owned by the consigner. All animals must be under 12 months of age. Animals must be halter broke. Animals must have a desirable disposition. Animals should be show ring ready (washed, clipped, etc.). If the animal is registered, registration papers must be current and ready for transfer or the animal will be sold as commercial. No animal shall be misrepresented by age, breed, weight, etc. Consignor must agree to the terms of the sale committee.

Health papers from a veterinarian must accompany the heifers to the sale. It is recommended for all show calves to be dehorned (unless it is a horned breed), dewormed, free of external parasites and vaccinated for the following diseases: Blackleg, IBR, BVD, PI3 and BRSV. Brucellosis testing is no longer a requirement.

A committee of three will screen each show calf when unloaded for quality and structural soundness and set the sale order based upon general conformation, quality and disposition.

A \$30.00 consignment fee is to accompany the entry form. A \$75.00 sales fee will be deducted from the total sales proceeds. Your total sales cost will be \$105 per show calf.
